We discussed the potential direction this could take us for funds and support but we determined we need to propose a route for this to continue forward.

Street Lights

Tom reported that he has made an offer to the city of Zimmerman for street lights they are not using. If his offer is accepted we would have lights for several park areas that could use better lighting.

Ag Lime For Ball Fields

Tom wants more information from Ed and the softball association before we commit to what we are doing. Brian asked about the process and why we couldn't just add the new ag line over the old. Tom explained that without removing the powdery top layer first it would float to the top when it got wet and defeat the purpose of the whole project.
