

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE PRINCETON CITY COUNCIL HELD ON
MARCH 26, 2012, 5:20 P.M. IN THE CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS**

Acting Mayor Paul Whitcomb called the meeting to order. Council members present were Thom Walker and Dick Dobson. Mayor Jeremy Riddle and Victoria Hallin were absent. Staff present was Administrator Mark Karnowski and City Clerk Katie Hunter.

CONSIDERATION OF MODIFYING GOLF COURSE LIQUOR LICENSE TIMEFRAME

Karnowski explained THAT THE Golf Course's Liquor License was just approved at Thursday, March 22nd's meeting for the period of April 1, 2012 through December 31, 2012. Because of the better than average weather, the Princeton Golf Course is now open and would like to sell liquor.

Karnowski went on to add that the Golf Course is requesting an early start date of March 27 and in which case, the end date would be December 26, 2012 instead of December 31, 2012 – just to keep the number of dates the same.

The insurance end date will have to coincide with the license end date.

Further, the city is requiring that the Golf Course pay each attending Council Member \$40.00 because they called the Special Meeting.

WALKER MOTIONED TO APPROVE THE EARLY START DATE OF MARCH 27, 2012 FOR THE INTOXICATING ON SALE LIQUOR LICENSE FOR THE PRINCETON GOLF COURSE. DOBSON SECONDED THE MOTION. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY (3 AYES, 0 NAYS).

DOBSON MOVED TO ADJOURN AT 5:40 P.M. WALKER SECONDED THE MOTION. ON THE VOTE: AYES - 3; NAYS - 0. THE MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
