

Trails

Pioneer Park offers natural hiking trails for users, while Mark Park contains a paved trail around the facility. The Princeton Park Board is working hard to add to the trail system throughout Princeton. A new one-mile trail will be paved this summer (2014) on the south end of town, beginning across from Crystal Cabinets at Rum River Drive and ending at 313th Avenue in Baldwin Township. Part of the Great Northern Trail, it will eventually connect all the way to Elk River.

The City has applied for federal funding to pave just under two miles of trails throughout the southern portion of the City to make connections to important destinations. Starting at the Great Northern Trail, it will run along Rum River Drive up to Coborn's, to the existing sidewalk on the east side of Rum River Drive, west along Northland Drive to Fairview and Sterling Pointe, and then north through the former railroad bed, and eventually to Mark Park.


Riebe Park
